YOU ARE THE REFEREE!

Situation: A player takes a throw however as there are no other players anywhere near him he throws the ball in and then immediately kicks the ball down towards the opposition goal.

DECISION: An INDIRECT FREE KICK is awarded against the thrower as he played the ball before any other player touched it.

What is an INDIRECT FREEKICK you say?

For certain offences it is awarded (Offside offence for example!) and you cannot score a goal DIRECT from the kick until another player has played or touched the ball.

The Referee shows he has awarded an Indirect Free Kick when he raises his hand in the air when the kick is taken and keeps it raised until another player has touched the ball!

RESULTS OF MATCHES PLAYED 31ST MARCH 2012

Under 12s lost to Guildford McCredie (Red) 2-5 at Phillips Park:
