Against a full team, and their reserves, the Lidcombe team of seven was forced to work twice as hard to cover the entire field. In the first half. Pendle Hill was under fire from Lidcombe who displayed great skill and determination, proving to be a serious threat. However, without the usual playing combinations attacking and power, Lidcombe were unable

to take advantage of any opportunities and were exhausted by half time as Pendle Hill took advantage with two goals late in the first half. Nevertheless, the magnificent seven persisted. Andrew Lylo replaced Mitchell Dielevski as goalkeeper and did a great job in saving a few close shots. James Lawandos and Samuel Zubkov also put up strong performances as strikers, but without their usual supporting players they struggled to find the net. Pendle Hill managed to crack the resilient defence of Camryn Bachelor and Kin and Kennu Challenger to extend their lead to three goals.
