RESULTS OF MATCHES PLAYED 4TH AUGUST 2012 (CONT)

Under 11s defeated Newington 2-1 at Phillips Park:

Lidcombe took on Newington in the local derby at Phillips Park. In what was one of the teams best displays this season Lidcombe dominated play with great skill, ball control and field possession. Christopher May gave Lidcombe an early lead when he easily converted a penalty in the 6th minute. Lidcombe controlled the match

but were caught out two minutes before half time when a long ball through was gathered up by Newington to level the score. The second half was no different to the first and Lidcombe's great play was well rewarded with the best goal the team has scored all year when Tomislav Teklic calmly took the ball from a

Newington attacker and fed it to Blake Batchelor who put a great ball through to Salim Mhajer to take it towards the goal-line and, in a very unselfish move, cut the ball across to Arti Nithinanthan to slot it in for the winning goal. And outstanding team performance leading up to the semi-finals.
