Our coaches and managers also deserve special mention as it is a big commitment they make to give up their Saturday mornings for almost six months of the year as well as attend Phillips Park every Wednesday night for training to ensure the children get a game of soccer each week.

Lastly, but not least, thanks to the other members of the management committee - Alex Morozoff, Lorraine Kratz, Steve May, Trent Smith and Grant Leslie - for the support they provided James and I throughout the season.

**Daniel ("Frank the Tank") JAMES:** Probably got a bit of a surprise to find himself back out on the field after performing so well in goals last year, but with a specialist keeper coming on board we were able to utilise Danny in the midfield where he turned in some determined displays, including a standout performance in the major semi- final

against Guilford where he broke the deadlock with a goal straight off a corner and set up our other goal not long after. However, with Frank not at peak fitness there was never much complaint when it was time for his turn on the interchange bench.

A bit unlucky not to get a run in the Grand Final win over Coptic as, just when he was due to go on in the second half, 2 quick goals to Coptic which brought back the score back to 4 -3 saw a change in plans.

**Steve MAY:** Faced with a long wait for an operation after rupturing his posterior cruciate ligament in the second round when filling in for Greystanes, Steve's season looked like it could be over. However, showed plenty of Congo spirit to get back out on the paddock midway through the season after putting in a lot of rehab work on the knee and while it obviously still troubled him there was a lot to admire about his determined efforts.

**Aaron SIVASOTHY:** Aaron (or Harry or Ahmed as he is now also known) played steadily throughout the season mostly in the mid field, but he also filled in capably at centre back when the need arose. Also scored 2 cracking goals in our first game, but couldn't find the back of the net after that.

**Trent SMITH:** As we have come to expect from this great competitor, “Angry” worked hard in the midfield all season where he covered a lot of territory and never stopped running. Also managed to put away 4 goals and, for a change, they all went in the back of the opposition’s net !

**Tito TEALDO:** A lively customer who tackled aggressively and showed some nice touches in the mid field. He certainly lived up to the promise he showed last year when awarded the Most Consistent Reserve Grade trophy.

**Prabu WEERASINGHE:** Another new signing who showed plenty of dash and some nice ball skills in his many runs down the right wing. However, some late Friday nights after work often saw “Prabs” happy to take his turn on the interchange bench after a few energy sapping runs. Finished the season without a goal to his credit, but it wasn’t for lack of trying.

# YOU ARE THE REFEREE

Ok all you budding Referees, Let's see how you go with these scenarios prepared by the Cong's own "Walking Rule Book"

**Q.** A player taking a throw in, throws the ball to his own goalkeeper who chips the ball back to him and he then heads it back to the keeper who catches the ball.

**Decision.** **Law 12 (Fouls and Misconduct).**  
**The goalkeeper must not touch the ball with his hands after it has been deliberately kicked to him by a team mate and he may not touch the ball with his hands after he receives it directly from a throw in taken by a team mate.**  
**Therefore in is play on!**

**Q.** A penalty has been awarded close to fulltime. The match has been extended to allow the taking of the penalty kick.  
The attacking player takes the kick and it hits the post and another attacker has run in and kicked the ball into the goal.

**Decision.** **Law 14 (The Penalty Kick).**  
**NO GOAL.** The extension of playing time to take a penalty kick is only until the kick is completed. The kick is deemed complete if a goal is scored directly from the penalty kick or if the penalty kick is saved by the goalkeeper or is missed by the attacker taking the kick.

**Q.** A player kicks the ball and it hits the corner post and does not cross the touch line or goal line.

**Decision.** **Law 9 (Ball In and Out of Play).**  
**PLAY ON.** The ball is in play if it rebounds off a goalpost, cross bar or corner flagpost and remains in the field of play.
