second half effort saw Lidcombe put St Mats on the back foot with two early goals to Mat James.

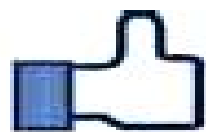
The Congs had their chances to get back on level terms with missed a opportunity falling to Andreas Correa in front of goal and a dubious off side going against Lidcombe.
