Under 7's Played OLQP (Blue) at Phillips Park

Under 9's (Blue) defeated Wentworthville Uniting 3-0 at Phillips Park

Once again this game was won because the Cong side worked as a team, with each player performing well in his assigned field position. It was a really good effort by everyone on the day, and there was some excellent running and passing on display. The midfielders and defenders made it almost impossible for the Wentworthville side to get near the Cong's goal - well done to the wall of Lidcombe defenders - Garang, Keith and Tito. On the other hand, the Cong side was constantly pressuring the Wentworthville goal, which it must be noted, was also well-defended.

The initial Cong's goal was worth waiting for and it came in the first half. Anthony Mylonas made a scorching run up the right wing and delivered a perfect centre kick, Sailesh moved to the ball and gave a cracker of a pass forward to Hissham, Hissham received the ball and then somehow threaded it through the slimmest of gaps between the Wentworthville goalkeeper and goal post. In the second half, Sailesh made his goalkeeping debut, and with the midfielders Vithushan, Sivanujan and Roland combining well, the Cong's kept up the pressure on the opposition.
