Ok all you budding Referees, Let's see how you go with these scenarios prepared by the Cong's own "Walking Rule Book"

Q. A player taking a throw in, throws the ball to his own goalkeeper who chips the ball back to him and he then heads it back to the keeper who catches the ball.

Decision. Law 12 (Fouls and Misconduct).

The goalkeeper must not touch the ball with his hands after it has been deliberately kicked to him by a team mate and he may not touch the ball with his hands after he receives it directly from a throw in taken by a team mate.

Therefore it is play on!

A penalty has been awarded close to fulltime. The match has been extended to allow the taking of the penalty kick.
 The attacking player takes the kick and it hits the post and another

attacker has run in and kicked the ball into the goal.

Decision. Law 14 (The Penalty Kick).

NO GOAL. The extension of playing time to take a penalty kick is only until the kick is completed. The kick is deemed complete if a goal is scored directly from the penalty kick or if the penalty kick is saved by the goalkeeper or is missed by the attacker taking the kick.

Q. A player kicks the ball and it hits the corner post and does not cross the touch line or goal line.

Decision. Law 9 (Ball In and Out of Play).

PLAY ON. The ball is in play if it rebounds off a goalpost, cross bar or corner flagpost and remains in the field of play.
