UNDER 9 BLUE

2015 was an outstanding year for the Under 9 Blue team. In a remarkable feat they were undefeated in all their Saturday games scoring a total of 69 goals and conceding only 5.

Progressing to and then winning the Grand Final was a deserved outcome and was the icing on the cake.

In reflecting on how they achieved this, the following observations are offered:

1. Enthusiasm - they thoroughly enjoyed playing the game of soccer. Whether it was a practice game in the cold at Wednesday night training, or the competition games themselves, they were incredibly motivated - they just wanted to get out there and compete - and then play more games if they were on offer.
2. Superb support and encouragement from parents and friends - this set the tone for the Saturday matches, and with so much good-natured support from the sideline, the team got heaps of extra motivation. Assistance was also provided at Wednesday night training, a contribution that is much appreciated.
3. Individuals' fitness - the Under 9 Blue team was very fortunate to have so many players who showed masses of commitment, putting in a full effort each and every match they played. The team outran and outlasted every team in the Under 9 competition. Quite simply, the Congs just never stopped!
4. Individuals' skills and natural abilities - Goalkeeper, defenders, midfielders and strikers demonstrated excellent understanding of what was required of their field positions; players could change their field positions with ease if required; and there was plenty of individual brilliance on display.
5. Teamwork - this is the area where the team went from strength to strength. Particularly in the latter half of the season, and especially in the Semi Final and Grand Final, their teamwork just got better and better. A vital part of this was the trust that developed amongst all the players.
6. Patience - on so many occasions, even when not leading a match, the team persisted with their efforts because they believed they could win. A good example of this was Round 4 against Hills Spirit (Green), where the score was 0-0 with less than five minutes remaining, but the Congs then overpowered the opposition by piling on three unanswered goals. Further examples were the Semi and Grand Final games where the side came back from being a goal down.
7. Playing extra games - a number of the Under 9s played in the NSW CFA South Zone representative team, and also in matches with older teams such as the Congs Under 10s and even the Under 11s. This exposure to a more advanced level of playing was of benefit to them, in gaining an understanding of, and experience in, more advanced levels of the game.
8. Sportsmanship - clearly the Under 9s were an ambitious team, and those ambitions were realised, yet they were considerate and disciplined in their behaviour on the field. This was a very pleasing aspect of their game.
9. Sideline video - where available, this helped the Coach identify what worked and what didn't work, and how players could improve their game. They also provide a lasting memory of some of the team's fine performances.
10. They listened to the Coach - and won anyway!

These observations provide an insight into how enjoyable and satisfying it has been to provide the role of Coach to the Under 9 Blue team in 2015. This marvellous year was also the result of the greater team effort - players, parents, supporters and the club - well done, thank you and congratulations all.

The players in the team were:

Hissham AHMADI: Hissham shows amazing dedication and effort every time he takes the field. In 2015 he was a Zone representative player and was also the team captain on many occasions, including in the Grand Final. Always ready to take the ball forward for a chance to score, he once again achieved the status of leading goalscorer in the Under 9 competition. Already a great player, he has become even better this year by including clever and accurate passing into his repertoire. 2015 has been another fantastic season for Hissham.

Tito AKOL: One of the younger players in the Under 9s, at the same time Tito is also one of the 'elders' of the team, having been a constant presence since joining the Congo Kickers. Tito's main position on the field this year has been as left defender, with an occasional role as a midfielder. He is one of the reasons why so few goals were scored against his side in 2015. He is a formidable presence, who constantly stops opposition attackers in their tracks, and so often turns play around with well-directed clearances.

Sailesh ARULANANTHAM: Sailesh's efforts in the midfield were rewarded this year with his first goal. YOU ARE THE REFEREE

Ok all you budding Referees, Let's see how you go with these scenarios prepared by the Congs' own "Walking Rule Book"

- Q.** Playing at Phillips Park running down hill towards the B.B.Q in the second half Noge takes a goal kick that goes straight to Matthew Hyde who is, as usual, very slow getting back into position and is just outside the opposition's penalty area, in an "off-side position". Mat turns shoots and puts the ball in the back of the net.

Decision. **Law 11 (Off-side).**
A player shall not be declared offside if he receives the ball directly from a goal kick, a throw-in or a corner.
Therefore you award a GOAL!

- Q.** The referee awards an INDIRECT free kick and the player taking the kick blasts the ball at the goal. It rebounds off you, the Referee, and goes straight into the net.

Decision. **Law 13 – Free Kicks**
No Goal. A goal can only be scored from an indirect free kick if it subsequently touches another player before it enters the goal.
Play is to be restarted by the awarding of a goal kick.
