Our current goal is finding an answer to colon cancer and this research is well underway at the prestigious Walter and Eliza Medical Research facility in Melbourne.

The potential of this research will be to offer personalized treatment that could not only kill the colorectal cancer cell but also offer a preventative option.

Colon or bowel cancer kills more than 4000 Australians each year. Shirley was claimed way too early in her life, a devastating loss to her family and many others.

Thanks for your help in beating this cancer and in some way bringing purpose to her death.

In this encounter the two teams were very evenly matched, with effective defensive lines that limited the chances for shots at goal. As a result, there was a lot of action for all the players, who put in a solid amount of work.

This match also provided the opportunity for the coach to consider tactics to work on, when faced with a tight contest like this. One area for focus (and practice) is the timing of passes from backs and midfielders to the forwards.

The Wentworthville defenders were very good at moving up field in a coordinated way, so as to put the Lidcombe strikers in offside position when the pass forward was made from our midfielders (this was also a part of Wentworthville's effective defence).

Another area of focus for the team, is to consider making more use of the space on the field. As this was a very close match, the only goal came early on, from a stray back pass which made its way over the Lidcombe goal

line, as the result of a simple miscommunication.

To their credit, the Lidcombe team bounced back from this and made every effort to even the score, but a very (and equally) determined Wentworthville side maintained their lead until the final whistle.

As usual Renee, Hayden and Sweekar (despite a leg injury) were all solid.

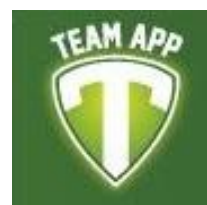
The team played well as a team and combined with their individual skills, did what they needed to win this game.
