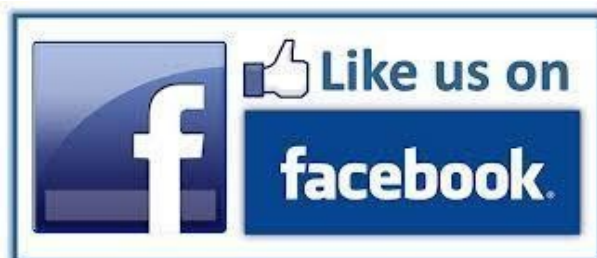

A recommendation to the team for improvement is to consider better using the space on the field, and to use longer passes. Quite often throughout this match, many players (and hence the action) were compressed together, often turning the event into a moving scrum. Against stronger teams, it will be vital for Lidcombe to make full and

correct use of player positioning, which (it must be said) the team has shown they can do, in previous matches.

In any case, this match produced some great individual and combination play, with the result never being in doubt.
