

Sydney Cup defeated Mortdale Oatley Baptist 3-1 at Yatama Park

It was another tough game for the Sydney Cup Congo's. Lidcombe found themselves under constant pressure right from the opening whistle. This was the first time all season that we came up against a very well organized team with a skillful midfield. After being constantly outplayed in the middle of the park it was a long ball to striker Stephen James that allowed Lidcombe to open the scoring after 20 minutes.

Mortdale continued with their game plan of controlling possession and high aggressive pressure in defence which was troubling the Congs. This paid results, minutes before half time, when they scored following a defensive mix up after veteran defender, Steven May, left the field through injury. A valiant diving effort by keeper, John Mylonas, was not enough as the ball was pushed just inside the post.

The second half saw Lidcombe decide to 'Go Long' at every opportunity, to avoid giving the ball to the Mortdale midfield. This saw Lidcombe able to get the ball to our strikers more often to create chances but we were still found ourselves under pressure at our own end. Two disallowed goals for offside and shots just missing or well saved by John Mylonas was keeping Lidcombe in the game.

With sixteen minutes remaining in the match it was again a long ball to Stephen James, who had switched to the right, that broke the deadlock. Then with five minutes remaining and Mortdale pushing forward for an equaliser, Daniel James found space to send a long range shot from near halfway that sailed over the Mortdale goalkeeper and into the back of the net to seal victory.
