### **Under 10 (Blue) lost to Guildford McCredie (White) 2-1 at Everley Park**

After having a bye in our first round the young under 10s side eagerly arrived at Everley Park for our first competition match of 2021 against Guildford white. It was always going to be a tough contest against one of the top sides in the competition with no available substitutes putting us further on the back foot from the commencement of the match. Guildford dominated possession and field position for much of the first half with the ball only briefly entering their half as a result of large kicks from saves by Likhil. Despite the dominance shown by Guildford with the ball they only had 1 genuine chance to score and did so when our defence was not desperate enough to shut down the ball from in front of our net. The selfless defending by all Lidcombe players in the first half was highlighted by Ricky putting his body on the line to stop a rocket of a shot which resulted in him taking no further part in the match.

Chasing the match in the second half with 8 players meant that the mentality of the side was that there was nothing to lose. We knew that the attempts to dribble the ball past Guildford in the first half failed miserably and so there was a renewed emphasis on passing the ball. This brought some more success with the ball spending far less time in our defensive 1/3 of the field and much more time in midfield and attack. All that was missing was the final ball kicked past their defenders on half way for Mirhat to run onto and score. Eventually Guildford managed another clear cut chance when Thanish lost his man who smashed the ball into the top right corner of the net. The never die attitude of the team was then further on display when we passed the ball to Safal in attack who found some space to dribble straight through their tiring (and perhaps complacent) defenders to grab one back right as it was full time. A truly brilliant effort by all players, only let down by those who did not show up. Man of the match was Likhil with countless saves to keep us in the match until their unstoppable second goal with 2 minutes remaining in the match.

## **ACTIVE KIDS VOUCHER**

For 2020 the STATE GOVERNMENT will again issue an ACTIVE KIDS VOUCHER to school aged children

### **BELOW IS A SUMMARY OF THE VOUCHER.....**

#### **Who is eligible to claim the voucher?**

Every child (4.5 – 18 years' old) enrolled in school from Kindergarten to Year 12 will be eligible for an Active Kids Voucher. This includes those who are home-schooled or enrolled in secondary school education at TAFE NSW.

It will *not* be Means Tested and two vouchers will be available for every child in the family annually. There will be no limits on the number of applications per family, as long as every child is enrolled in school.

#### **How do you download a voucher?**

Parents/guardians/carers with legal responsibility of an eligible child resident in NSW will be able to download a voucher from an online platform. The platform will be run by Service NSW and can be accessed through their [website](#).
