This was a great effort shown by all despite the lack of experience of most of the players resulting in the defence having a more active game than they would have liked, with all players (even the supposed forward!) contributing.

### **Under 8-10 Girls lost to Inter Parramatta 0-2 at PH Jeffery Reserve**

The girls worked hard for each other. Good to see some nice professional soccer and great improvement. Unfortunately the girls had a 2-0 loss but will come back a lot stronger and greater next time. Well done girls.

### **Under 10 (Blue) lost to Guildford McCredie (Red) 1-3 at Phillips Park**

Following last week's comfortable win against last placed Inter Parramatta, we returned to Phillips Park full of confidence that we would be able to at least draw against Guildford (Red). With Zachary unavailable to play, we had a new looking defensive line (Ricky, Paul and Adam) who looked to be exposed early on in the match with Guildford creating a few half chances before they sorted out who to mark. The new trio did well to shut down just about every attack despite Guildford spending the overwhelming majority of the first half with possession in our half of the field. Their only genuine chance in the first half occurred right before half time when their striker found some space at the top of the box to shoot to the top right corner only for Likhil to tip the ball onto the cross bar with the rebounding shot going narrowly wide of the goal. Heading into half time at 0 – 0 was a credit to all our players who showed a lot of discipline to keep their positions and work together as a team to shut down their attacks.

The second half saw the match open up with our team able to move more comfortably and successfully 'play out' from goal kicks and consistently get the ball to the midfield at half way. Unfortunately, we were unable (or perhaps unwilling) to play the ball in behind their defenders from half way for Mirhat and Thanmukil to run onto which meant we were again constantly under pressure from their attacks. Eventually Guildford managed to strike a blow and scored with about 10 minutes of the match remaining, and scored 2 more goals soon after. To our credit we kept trying to attack and got one back with Safal running through to once again score on full time. It was a tough match in the midday sun with no substitutes but we were not helped by our midfield running up to attack when they did not have the energy to get back and assist our defenders when we lost the ball as the second half went on, as well as our inability or unwillingness to put through balls for our strikers from half way – two critical aspects of the game we need to improve if we are to get results in the reverse fixtures against both Guildford sides who now sit at the top end of the table while we are currently outside the top 4 despite us being as good as them.

## **ACTIVE KIDS VOUCHER**

For 2020 the STATE GOVERNMENT will again issue an ACTIVE KIDS VOUCHER to school aged children

**BELOW IS A SUMMARY OF THE VOUCHER.....**

### **Who is eligible to claim the voucher?**

Every child (4.5 – 18 years' old) enrolled in school from Kindergarten to Year 12 will be eligible for an Active Kids Voucher. This includes those who are home-schooled or enrolled in secondary school education at TAFE NSW.

It will *not* be Means Tested and two vouchers will be available for every child in the family annually. There will be no limits on the number of applications per family, as long as every child is enrolled in school.

### **How do you download a voucher?**

Parents/guardians/carers with legal responsibility of an eligible child resident in NSW will be able to download a voucher from an online platform. The platform will be run by Service NSW and can be accessed through their [website](#).
