TRENT SMITH 700 GAMES

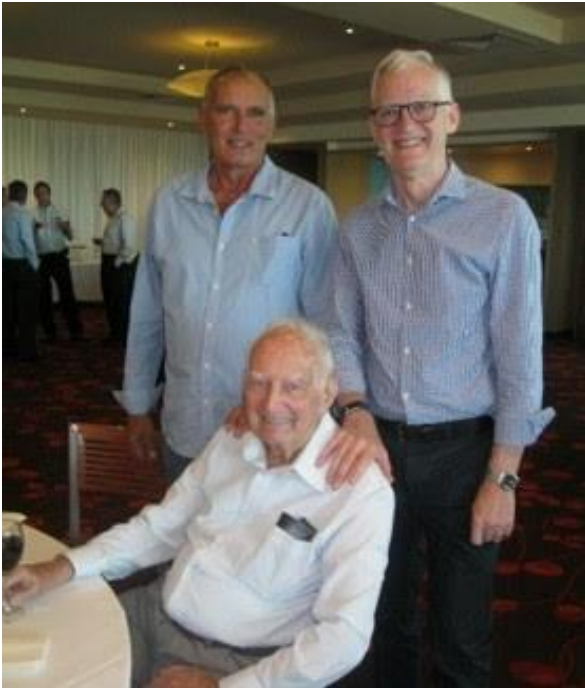

Pictured is veteran Congo Jimmy Pincott and his wife Dawn reading Jimmy's "Congs Career" which details his career with our club from when he commenced with the 1944 Under 12s team until he retired at the end of the 1997 season after playing in the Raahauge Cup sides.

In his regular role as an attacking forward (who took no prisoners!) Jimmy played 566 games and scored 120 goals in his 38 season long career.

His first competition wins were in 1947 (Under 14s) and 1948 (Under 16s).

In 1968 he captained the Premier Reserve side to a Grand Final victory – to date, the only Congs side that has won a Premier League or Premier Reserve competition.

He received the club's highest honour, Life Membership, in 1989.

Jimmy and Dawn now live the quiet life in the small town of Millfield in the Hunter Valley.

Although turning 90 in March 2023, Jimmy still takes an active interest in his old club with Dawn and Jimmy always special guests at our Anniversary Dinners.
