Player absences mainly due to family commitments overseas, injuries and illnesses also had an unsettling effect on the team's performances throughout the season. It was a very rare Saturday when we able to field a full-strength side and my thanks to Margaret Kabat and her Under 12 Girls – in particular, Alexis Richards, Zoe Kabat and Joanne Chen – for helping us out in many games.

It was obviously a difficult season for everyone concerned and my thanks to the boys and the parents for their patience and for continuing to support the team despite so many disappointing losses.

Hopefully, if we get enough players keen to play again next year we can have a much better season. The players in the team were:

Zak AZMI: Continued on from the promise he showed as goalkeeper towards the end of last season, performing well between the "sticks in most games although he sometimes had the occasional lapses in concentration. He needs to learn to keep his mind on the game all the time so that he is ready to react when opposition attackers come threatening.

Makaii JAMES: As we have come to expect he played soundly in his familiar right back position, but with a shortage of experienced defenders he was often seen showing the initiative to defend further up the field when the situation demanded it. It was also pleasing to see him attempting to head a very high ball kicked by OLQP (White) in our last game even if it did result in an own goal when the ball came off the back of his head and straight into our goals!

His game improved to the extent he gained selection in the Zone Representative team and, for his efforts Zac has been awarded the teams' **Most Improved Player Trophy.** He certainly didn't lack confidence, always ready to give the coach a bit of advice if he thought it necessary.

Thanish MAYUTHARAN: A frustrating youngster to coach. He really loves his soccer, has the size and ball skills to cause plenty of problems up front in attack and scored some good goals. However, he sometimes "switches off" and needs to be constantly thinking about what is happening on the field and how he can get more involved in the game.

Paul McGARVEY: Even though required to play soccer for his school on Saturdays, Paul showed great team spirit by backing up and playing for us whenever possible where he played with his usual enthusiasm and determination.

Caleb PALLETT: Another newcomer who always tried his best, but he needs to show a greater awareness of what is happening on the field and try to get more involved with play wherever possible. No doubting his keenness and he will benefit greatly from his first season of soccer.

Jiwu PARK: Due to the lack of experienced defenders, particularly in the midfield, I had to move him to the centre midfield rather than play in his preferred position out on the left. Jiwu worked tirelessly in his new position and the "boss" certainly appreciated his efforts. It was also pleasing to see him heading the ball whenever the situation required it.

Vihash SUTHARSAN: Could not play quite a few games in the early part of the season due to his absence overseas and we certainly missed him. Ok all you budding Referees, Let's see how you go with these scenarios prepared by the Cong's own "Walking Rule Book"

Q. Playing at Phillips Park running downhill towards the B.B.Q in the second half Christopher May takes a goal kick that goes straight to Jack Husseini who is, as usual, very slow coming back into position and is just outside the opposition's penalty area, in an "off-side position". After he receives the ball Jack turns, shoots, and puts

the ball in the back of the net.

Decision. Law 11 (Off-side).

There is no offside offence if a player receives the ball directly from a goal kick,

a throw-in or a corner.

Therefore you award a GOAL!

Q. A player is passing the ball to a team mate unfortunately for you as referee, the ball strikes you and lands at the feet of an opposing player who kicks the ball into the

gaols!

Decision. As Referee if the ball strikes you must stop the game and recommence the

game with a drop ball to the team that was passing the ball. Therefore NO

GOAL.

Q. A player takes a corner kick, the ball hits the goalpost and bounces directly back to

him without touching another player. He then crosses the ball into the goal area!

Decision. After taking a free kick, goal kick, corner, kick-off or throw-in player MUST NOT

play the ball a second time before it has been touched or played by another player. Indirect free kick against the offender where the infringement occurred.

Q. You, the referee award an INDIRECT free kick and the striker blasts the ball at the

goal and goes straight into the net.

Decision. Law 13 - Free Kicks

No Goal. A goal can only be scored if it subsequently touches another player

before it enters the goal.

Play is to be restarted by the awarding of a goal kick.

Q. The defending team receives a free-kick. The ball is passed back to the goalkeeper,

who is standing in front of his goal, to clear the ball up field. However he misses the

ball and it goes straight into his own goal!

Decision. Law 13 - Free Kicks

Award a corner kick! If the defending team plays the ball directly into their own

goal from a free kick play is to recommence from a corner taken by the

attacking team..
